Always remember that the Authority is the Scripture not the preacher!
What about using Al platforms — like Gemini or ChatGPT or the new Grok 4 to write

- Let me start with; FIRST read the Bible without any helps including helps just
- Let me start with; **FIRST** read the Bible without any helps including helps just read and pray read it over and over before using Commentaries or other study helps.
- Study **helps**; commentaries, lexicons, dictionaries, articles, *books*, Google searches, and so on.
- That's called **research** and we've been doing this for a **thousand years** getting help from **other people** to **communicate our thoughts** in new ways,
- But here's what I would say is wrong with using AI exclusively or just copying another man's sermons. Don't do it!

- Because your number one job as *Pastor Teacher* of your church is to *read*,
 pray over a text, understand, and apply and then proclaim it's truth to God's people,
- **1 Timothy 3:2** A bishop then must be blameless, the husband of one wife, temperate, sober-minded, of good behavior, hospitable, **able to teach**;
 - That is the gift God has given to you! You must do the work yourself;
- You are to work hard, spending hours wrestling with the text to understand the authors meaning.
- **2 Timothy 2:15** Be diligent to present yourself approved to God, a worker who does not need to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.
 - That is the pastors job! "rightly dividing the word of truth."
- So can you **use** ChatGPT for **information**, just like you use *commentaries* and *articles* and *books*?...**Yes**! But **don't** use it for **composition! but, if you do** you need to tell your church before you preach Sunday morning, that this sermon was written by Grok or ChatGPT......
 - You need to do what Paul said in:

Colossians 3:16 Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom, teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord.

Hebrews The Supremacy of Christ The Powerful Word of God Hebrews 4:11-13 6/26/22

Intro

Open Your Bibles to **Hebrews chapter 4**, to this wonderful portion of scripture about **Resting**, in the **free Gift** of salvation offered by Jesus Christ,

- We all need Rest, *Correct*? but it's spiritual Rest and *confidence* in our salvation that we find throughout this chapter,
- The writer is calling the **unsaved** *person* to enter into Christ's salvation by **belief** in Jesus, and when he does he enters into *God's salvation rest.*
- But he also calls the **Believer** who is already **in** *God's* salvation rest to **continue** to live by **faith** in order to experience that moment by moment **rest** this side of glory,
 - So we enter salvations Rest by grace through faith and.....
 - We continue to live in salvations rest everyday by grace through faith.
- These passages teach us to, be *diligent* to *fully embrace* the **Rest** God has given to all who **believe** in Jesus Christ,
- And the warning is that *Unbelief* will keep *us* from experiencing the **joy** and **peace** of "*God's rest*"
 - · So, What will strengthen our Faith and keep us at Rest?
 - And What will reveal sin to the Unsaved and bring them to salvation?
 - · A: "The Powerful Word of God"

PRAY

v11 Let us therefore be diligent to enter that rest, lest anyone fall according to the same example of disobedience. 12 For the word of God is living and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart. 13 And there is no creature hidden from His sight, but all things are naked and open to the eyes of Him to whom we must give account.

- Now again, it's critical that you understand that this letter was written to believing and non believing, Jews who had left Judaism, to embrace Christianity,
 - They fellowshipped together in the same church but not all were saved,
 - The *unbelieving* Jews were at the point of **renouncing** their **professed faith** in Christ.
 - They were right on the edge and in danger of going back into Judaism,
- That's **why** the writer says; "Don't do what your forefathers did! Don't fall back as the generation did in Moses' time and die in the wilderness" "Instead "be diligent to enter into rest while it is still available....do it **Today**!"

The Priority of Entering Rest v11

- (KJV) translates v11 "Let us therefore be diligent to enter that rest,"
- To "diligent" {spoo-dad'-zo} means to labour or to exert one's self,
- IOW's to be diligent" means you have to do something... Right?
- You can't just, sit around and listen to the bible to be taught,

- You can't just, go to church, and take up space, thinking you're OK?
- But, to *labour* or to be *diligent* involves an **effort** on your part,
- Some people never understand that?

But, **Peter believed** that, listen to what he said in;

- **2 Peter 1:10** Therefore, brethren, be even more diligent to make your **call** and **election sure**, for if you do these things you will never stumble.
 - There's that word **Diligent** again,
 - Peter says to make an even *greater effort* {spoo-dad'-zo}
 - The word relates to *urgency* and it conveys *eagerness*, and *purpose*
- To "be more diligent" or to make certain for yourself; to certify; or confirm;
 Why is that so important?
 - Because there's nothing worse, than to **fear** that you're **not saved**.
 - Worry and despair result from that kind of uncertainty doubt and fear.
 - So Peter says be spiritually diligent to make sure for yourself!

And the "call and election" here is **not** an invitation, **but** God's sovereign selection in eternity past. "be even more diligent to make your **call** and **election** sure"

• How do you do that?

How can you know and have Confidence in your salvation?

- Notice what Peter says; "for if you do these things you will never stumble"
- Peter is referring to a list of **virtues** and moral values, like **temperance**, patience, godliness in the **previous verses**, of **2 Peter**,
 - IOW's as long as you diligently pursue godly virtues,
 - As long as you pursue a **holy life** and *spiritual growth*,
- Your life then, *demonstrates* that you were called and you were chosen. *Listen!* that is a wonderful, confidence to have! To you **know** your saved because you're *pursuing godliness*, you're doing *more*, "to *make your election sure!*"

That's what the writer of **Hebrews** is saying here, notice in **v11** Let us therefore **be** diligent to enter that rest, lest anyone fall according to the same example of disobedience.

- What he's saying here is to **be diligent** to enter that rest **or** you will **fall** like they did through **unbelief** in the wilderness.
- Don't fall back like the generation did in Moses' time and die in the wilderness... but strive... be diligent... labour, IOW's purpose to enter God's Rest!
 - The unbelieving Hebrews in the wilderness are the example he's talking about
- He says; "Don't be like them. Don't fall off because of unbelief, instead you enter into that rest."
- Listen!.... If an entire generation of Israelites failed to enter "that rest," then there must be very real danger here...Right?

 Illustration

It's like people who are warned of a raging forest fire burning toward them and the are told to evacuate *but*, some *stay* in their homes and when the fire comes, they are *overwhelmed* and *die* because they will **not** leave!

- They simply did not believe the danger was as great as they were told.
- That's the warning here, the failure of the *Hebrews* to *enter salvations rest*,
 - And some of the people in *that* early church were not *truly* saved.
- All, they had was a *profession* of faith, they did religious things but when life got hard, some were considering going **back** into Judaism,
- That's again, why the writer says "Be **diligent** to enter into rest while it is still available."
 - IOW's Don't wait! because you can't just play around with God and salvation,
- God can't be trifled with, and that comes out in v12 where the writer reveals
 The Diagnostic Word of God v12

v12 For the word of God is quick, and powerful, and sharper than any twoedged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.

- Now that verse is a favorite of most Christians and we use it to defend the Bible and the veracity of scriptures,
- But the context here is *salvation* and *being diligent* to enter that Rest! v11 Let us labour therefore to enter into that rest, lest any man fall after the same example of unbelief. 12 For the word of God...
 - That statement "For the Word of God" means by God's Authority!
 - · IOW's When God says something He means it!
- And notice he says; "the word of God is quick, and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword",
- So in it's *context* with **v11** it means that; God's Word will *pierce* right down into the **inner most** part of your **heart** to see if you're **really** a *True believer* or **not**.
- IOW's you don't just play around with God and salvation, because God's Word will penetrate your heart to *diagnose* if you're a true believer!

I say that because the word "for" in v12 joins up with v11 with a direct connection between laboring to enter God's rest and the diagnostic Word of God.

- God's word is *discerning* of the thoughts and intents of the heart.
- IOW's God's Word will diagnose the condition of your heart.
- And in the **context** of some of these folks *Unbelief*, here in this section, it's God's *word* that will **show them** whether their **profession** is **real** or a fake!

Listen, God's word is instructive and encouraging and it brings peace to all who read it

- But God's word also Judges, it penetrates, it slices through all of your innermost thoughts and intents of the heart"
 - It diagnoses, and exposes weather you are a true believer like a filet knife,

Listen! "If you profess Jesus Christ, **but** you've **never** truly **repented** of your sin... when **judgement comes**, the Word of God will **cut** you wide **open** and reveal the **hypocrisy** and the imposter you are!" (MacArthur)

Now there are **5 Specific Truths About the Word of God** that are revealed here; **1. God's Word is Alive.....** It's not a dead thing.

- The **Bible** is "*living*" because it is **God's Word**,
- And think about it?....because God is Eternal so are His words,
 Peter said;
- 1 Peter 1:23-25 having been born again, not of corruptible seed but incorruptible, through the word of God which lives and abides forever, because "All flesh is as grass, And all the glory of man as the flower of the grass. The grass withers, and its flower falls away, But the word of the LORD endures forever."
 - God's word is eternal, so when God says something, He means it!
 - God's Word is **alive** and when you **heard** the gospel and **believed** it, you were saved!
 - God's Word is **alive**, meaning it's **not** something that **WE** have to **energize**; *No*!
 - All we have to do is believe it, and let it go to do it's work!

Illustration

We Believe **what** God's word says about our sin and **repent** and that's when we are made **New Creations** in Christ, (2 Cor. 5:17)

• **Then** we tell **others** about it and it effects them!

Someone said; "The Word of God is like a caged lion, just release it and let it do it's work!"

- 1. God's Word is Alive.
- 2. God's Word is Powerful.
 - The word "powerful" is {en-er-gace'} from which we get the word "energy."
- God's word is *energetic*; it is **powerful** because it is **backed** by the power of Almighty God.
 - And when the word of God exposes unbelief it demonstrates its power, and accuracy.
- God meets our every need in His Word and the Holy Spirit works powerfully through the word of God.
- In Psalm 107 we are given a wonderful description of how God's word has **healing power** and the **power to deliver** from oppression

Psalm 107:19-20 "Then they cried out to the LORD in their trouble, and He saved them out of their distresses. He sent His word and **healed** them, and **delivered** them from their destructions."

- Oh the power of God's unalterable word,
- I thank God for the power of His word that **brought me** to **Christ**!

Illustration

- C. H. Spurgeon was saved by one single word from the Bible.
- He tells the story when he was **16**, and how he **wandered** into a small church one Sunday morning.
 - It was **stormy outside** so he came inside the church to get out of the rain.

- The **storm** was so **great** the pastor could not get across a stream to church,
- So in place of the pastor one of the elders, a **blacksmith** picked up his Bible and read from **Isaiah 45:22** "Look to Me, and be saved, all you ends of the earth! For I am God, and there is no other."
 - The old man spoke about 10 minutes and then all he could say was "Look!"
- He *pointed* to Spurgeon and said, "*Look*!" and *Spurgeon looked* that morning and was saved.... All it took was **ONE Powerful word**!
- 1. God's Word is Alive.
- 2. God's Word is Powerful.
- 3. God's Word Cuts Two Ways.

v12 "the word of God is.... sharper than any two-edged sword,

- The Bible is like a two-edged sword; meaning it cuts two ways.
- The word for **sword** here is {makh'-ahee-rah}
- The {makh'-ahee-rah} is a **short** sword, but extremely lethal,
- Invented by the Romans, and it became the weapon of choice for the Roman soldier, as they swung it back and forth, against their enemies,
 - So the {makh'-ahee-rah} by analogy is like the two-edged Word of God,
 - IOW's God's word does 2 things, The Word of God either saves or judges.

When the gospel is preached people either **reject** it, or **accept** it, **Right**?

- Whenever the **gospel** is read or preached, it either **regenerates** or **condemns**,
- God's word cuts and lays bare the heart a of a man,
- And if He sees **unbelief**, then the *piercing sword* becomes the **judgment** sword.
- God's word cuts 2 ways,

But for the Believer, God's word can cut away sin like a surgeon, to bring healing,

- God's word brings comfort and assurance to the weary soul,
- And when it's preached faithfully, it brings conviction!

Illustration

You may wonder at times, *How I know* what's going on in your life when I preach God's word?

- I don't have a clue!...I don't have special revelation or even track your cell phone!
- It's all about the sharpness of the Word of God,
- And when you hear it's Truth, it cuts, it exposes, it also encourages,
- God always delivers His message in just the *right place*, at the *perfect time*,
- · God's Word Cuts Two Ways, It Judges the sinner and corrects the Believer,
- 1. God's Word is Alive.
- 2. God's Word is **Powerful**.
- 3. God's Word **Cuts** Two Ways, and in doing that;
- 4. God's Word Pierces the Soul.
- "... piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow,"
 - That means God's word reaches us right where we live,
 - It gets down *inside* the heart and it *exposes* our vary **motives**,
- The **Bible** is **so powerful** that it is able to **penetrate** into the **spiritual** part of man, "the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow,"

- That's the *immaterial* part of us, our vary spirit, our internal souls, **Illustration**
 - A **sword** can only put a hole in someones physical body,
- **But** a sword *cannot* penetrate a **soul** or **spirit** because that's the part of you that's **immaterial,....**That's impossible,
- But the Word of God *penetrates* into the **inmost recesses** of a person's spiritual being,
 - His word begins to convict us of sin making us uncomfortable,
 - The Holy Spirit uses God's written word to bring both conviction and comfort
- But God's word when believed and received by a person, makes a person alive spiritually.

Romans 1:16 "For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ, for it is the power of God to salvation for everyone who believes..."

Illustration

Herbert Lockyer, tells the story of a *non-believing* **Irishman**.

- Someone gave him a New Testament.
- He had never read the Bible before and took it home and began to read it.
- One evening he said to his wife, "Wife, if this book is true, then we are sinners and we are lost."
- The next night he read again and he said, "Wife, if this book is true, then we can be saved." He was getting closer and closer to the truth.
- He read it and read it until he understood what Christ had done for sinners and with rejoicing in his heart he went to his wife one evening and said, "Wife, this book is true and I am saved!"
 - Only the Word of God can do that!..... It Pierces the Soul,
 - But notice here at the end of v12 that;

5. God's Word Judges the Heart

"...is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart,"

- "discerner" {krit-ee-kos'} means to analyze the facts, to be a critic,
- God's word when *read* or *heard* moves in and begins to *sift* out and *analyze* a persons motives,
 - God judges or critiques our thoughts, and our desires,
 - That's what the word means; to judge, "the thoughts and intents of the heart,"
- The *Bible* analyzes, **all** the evil actions of the *heart of man*, and shows the **sinner** his **need** of a Savior.
 - IOW's the truth of God's Word strips off the false.
 - The reason people hate the Bible is because it moves in and *convicts*,
- The Bible ultimately takes man to the point where he sees that his real problem is *unbelief*.
- That's because all of man's **excuses**, and **arguments** against Christianity are **rooted** in **unbelief**.

• But it's the **active**, **living** Word of God that penetrates through all the lies and false beliefs of man, so that man **must** make a **decision** to **believe** and be **saved** or to **reject** and **stay lost**.

So the 5 Specific Truths About the Word of God;

- 1. The Word of God is Alive
- 2. God's Word is Powerful.
- 3. God's Word Cuts Two Ways.
- 4. God's Word Pierces the Soul.
- 5. God's Word Judges the Heart
 - I'm thankful for God's powerful Word!
 - Oh Christian, do you **read** it, do you spend time **memorizing** it's promises?

Illustration

Charles Spurgeon said it best. "Bibles that are falling apart usually belong to people who aren't."

• IOW's if you want a life that's held together, you need to wear your Bible out.

Now it's in **v13** that the writer moves from the Power of God's Word to;

God's Ever Watchful Eyes v13

v13 "And there is no creature hidden from His sight, but all things are naked and open to the eyes of Him to whom we must give account."

- IOW's Don't think that you can fool God with all of your religious activity,
- Or **Don't** think that you can **fool God** by your *profession* of faith in Christ,
- You cannot fool God by leaving some sin behind for the moment and turning to Jesus for some fire insurance,
 - You can't fool God into believing you're for real if you're not! Can't be done!
 - Why?...Because everything is open and naked before him.
 - The word *naked* {goom-nos'} means *all the disguises are ripped off.*
 - The facts are laid bare.
 - · IOW's God sees you just as you are!
 - The phrase "open to the eyes of him" is interesting,
 - It's {trakh-ay-lid'-zo} you Droctors recognize it as *Trachea* the long tube in the throat,
- It's a word used in connection with **wrestling**, and it's used for seizing an opponent by the throat in such a way that he **can't move**.
 - And what it's saying is that we can't run from God forever,
 - Because there comes a time when God grabs us by the throat and holds us face to face.
 - · Meaning, Sooner or later, we will all face God!

Now, **Remember** that the *context* here is the Jewish **non believer** who was mixed in with the **true believers** in that early church,

- They were *professing Christians* but they were not *possessors* of salvation by Faith,
- And like the people **Moses led** through the wilderness, they were going to **die** because of **Unbelief**,

- They were going to leave the fellowship and go back to Judaism,
- That's why the writer **warns them** over and over in this section of scripture to make a decision "**Today**, do not haden your hearts but believe **Today**!"
- And here in v13 the writer makes it clear that they can't keep their Unbelief "hidden" from God.
- Because God **knows everything**. "all things are naked and open to the eyes of Him to whom we must give account."
 - God knows what a person is **thinking all** the time.
 - He knows where you go, and what you see and what you do!
 - God sees everything, a man's life is laid bare before Him,
 - No one can run anywhere from the all-knowing All-Mighty God.
 - God knows of every **lie**, of every **hypocrisy**, of every **dishonest act**,
 - The eyes of the Lord scan the soul and all of its thoughts and intents,
- God **sees** clearly either the **heart of belief** or the **rejection** of Jesus Christ and the **wicked** heart of **unbelief**,

Illustration

How would you like to have everything you have thought this week *projected* on the screen behind me?

- Oh how embarrassing! Right?
- If that happened you'd be shamed and the rest of us would be shocked!
- I'd probably have to quit the ministry!
- Listen! I don't know what you are thinking and you don't what I'm thinking,

but... God knows everything we are thinking!

• And one day we will stand before God to make account for our actions,

Conclusion

So...Why is it that so many **professing** Christians have **never** really entered into God's rest of salvation?

- The answer is; They don't read study and know God's Amazing and Powerful Word,
- But the unbeliever doesn't read so he never sees himself as the unworthy sinner in need of a Savior that the Bible declares him to be!
 - So What must be done to escape God's certain judgment?
 - You must BELIEVE. in the person Jesus Christ and His finished work for sin.
- Sinners must cease from their **own works** and **rest solely** in Christ's finished work for their sin.

Are you a True believer in Jesus Christ today?

- That is the only way to enter into **God's salvation rest**.
- And that comes freely as God's wonderful gift that cannot be earned,

Ephesians 2:8-9 For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, not of works, lest anyone should boast.

Listen!, **don't** you ever think for a minute that you're going to live your life **the way you want** to live it and God's **not** going to know.

- And don't you ever think that you're going to live and go your own way and never face God.
- Because **You will** one day stand before **All Mighty God** whose **Powerful Word** will **penetrate** and **lay bare** your whole life.
- And you will stand face to face, and everything will be revealed openly and totally to Him.
- •So as the writer of **Hebrews** says; " today, while you hear His voice, harden not your heart.
