# Blessed Assurance "Sons and Heirs" Romans 8:14-17

**Introduction:** 2 Corinthians 5:17- "If any man be in Christ..."

- \* A Christian is "in Christ" and "in Christ," all things become new.
  - 1) A new position (v.v. 1-4)—"in Christ Jesus"
  - 2) A new life (v. 13)—"in the Spirit"
  - 3) A new relationship (v.v. 14-17)
- \* We are sons and heirs adopted into God's family!
- \* We are both:
  - 1) Born into God's family (John 3)
  - 2) Adopted into God's family (a new standing)
- \* The two themes of our text are "son ship" and "heirship."
  - o This relation to God as "sons" and "heirs" implies a trustful intimacy.
- \* In this passage, Paul gives us three blessings from the Holy Spirit that bring the true believer a blessed assurance.

# **I.** The Holy Spirit Leads Us (v. 14)

- \* All Christians are led by the Spirit of God
  - o Paul is not talking about some "super saints"
  - o It is all Christians!
  - A. What does it mean to be led by the Spirit of God?
    - 1. He renews our mind
      - a. How?- By the Word of God (the Bible)
      - b. Romans 12
    - 2. He stirs our heart
      - a. To pray (v. 15- "cry Abba Father")
      - b. To praise
      - c. To proclaim
    - 3. He directs our will

- a. To walk in holiness
- b. Philippians 2- "...work out your own salvation..."
- c. The Holy Spirit leads us to live for God's glory
- \* If God's Spirit is leading you, it is an assurance that you are "the sons of God" (v. 14).
  - o "Being led" are "sons," and all "sons" are "being led."

## B. What does Paul mean by "sons of God?"

- 1. "Sons" in Greek-"hulos" (a child matured enough to take on a family's privileges and responsibilities.)
- 2. (v. 16) "children" in Greek- "tekna" ("born ones")
  - a. Contrast the two

<u>Illustration</u>: Babies don't enjoy freedom.

3. We are "sons being led by the Spirit."

## **II.** The Holy Spirit Frees Us (v. 15)

- \* We are not only being "led by the Spirit," we are also loved by the Father.
- \* Three facts about the Spirit freeing us:

#### A. We have not received the Spirit of bondage again to fear (v. 15)

- 1. We are "sons" not "slaves" to sin
- 2. No fear of condemnation (v. 1)

## B. We have received the Spirit of adoption (v. 15)

1. The word "adoption" is only used by Paul

Illustration: In Old Testament- Moses; Esther by Mordecai; Mephibosheth

- 2. Paul took the idea from the Roman world (not Jewish).
  - a. "Adoption" signified being granted the full rights and privileges of son ship in the family to which one does not belong by nature.
- 3. When you became a Christian you were:
  - a. Regenerated (God as Creator—His power)
  - b. <u>Justified</u> (God as Judge—His righteousness)
  - c. Adopted (God as a Loving Father—your position and power)

#### C. "We cry 'Abba Father"

1. "Abba" is Aramaic—it's an intimate form of the word "Father."

Illustration: "Daddy" or "Papa"

Illustration: Jesus taught us in the Lord's Prayer and in the Garden of Gethsemane.

2. It's the reflexive response of a true child of God ("the Spirit cries out...")

- 3. "To think that God, Who is infinitely high, is intimately nigh."
- 4. Jesus taught in Matthew 6- "don't worry what you will eat or drink..."
- 5. We are free to rest in our "Abba's" love and care.

## **III.** The Holy Spirit Assures Us (v. 16)

- \* Again, it is the "Spirit Himself."
- \* What does the Holy Spirit do for God's children?
  - o (v. 16) "Beareth witness with our spirit that we are the children (Greek "tekna" or "born ones") of God."
- \* The Spirit gives us blessed assurance because:
  - 1) He leads us (v. 14)
  - 2) He <u>cries out</u> from us (v. 15)
  - 3) He speaks to us (v. 16)
  - A. What is the basis for assurance?
    - 1. The Word of God the Father (1 John 5:13)
    - 2. The Work of God the Son (John 3:16)
    - 3. The Witness of God the Holy Spirit (v. 16)
      a.Do you have this witness?
      b.If not, trust in Jesus today!

# **CONCLUSION**

- \* Paul ends with the results of being a child of God.
  - 1) Heirs of God; joint heirs with Christ (v. 17)
    - a. All of God's children will inherit the new heavens and new earth!
  - 2) We suffer with Him now (v. 17)
  - 3) We will also share in His glory (v. 17)
    - a. The Holy Spirit is the down-payment.
    - b. "For I reckon that the sufferings of..." (v. 18)
- \* We have a new hope!
