Is Life Worth Living? "Life, What's It All About" Ecclesiastes 11-12

Introduction: It has been said that "Life is like a good book; the further you get into it, the more it begins to make sense."

- * How about you today?
 - o Are you frustrated with life?
- * In the book of Ecclesiastes, Solomon looked at life and said in chapter 1:2 "Vanity of vanities, all is vanity."
 - He said this because he looked at life from "under the sun."
 - o It is life without God.
 - o It is monotonous and empty.
- * Today, Solomon comes to the end of his book and makes his conclusions—seeing God. He paints four pictures to help us understand what life is all about!

I. Life is an Adventure; Live by Faith in God (11:1-6)

- * In this section, Solomon used two activities to illustrate the idea of "living by faith."
 - 1) (v.v. 1-2) The merchant ("be benevolent")
 - 2) (v.v. 3-6) The farmer
- * Key- "you know not" (v. 2, v. 5, v. 6)
 - o "Nothing ventured, nothing gained"
 - o Jesus said in Mark 11:22-"...have faith in God"
 - o Habakkuk 2:4- "The just shall live by faith"
 - o Illustration- 1 Samuel 14- Jonathan and his armor bearer
- * F.B. Meyer- "You never test the resources of God until you attempt the impossible."
- * Jesus said- "Give and it shall be given..."

II. Life is a Gift from God (11:7-12:8)

- * How can we enjoy life?
 - o Solomon gives us three admonitions:
 - 1) Rejoice in your youth (v.v. 7-9)
 - 2) Remove sin from your life (v. 10)
 - a. Sin leads to sadness! It brings guilt to the mind and damage to the body!
 - b. Jesus said- "If your right hand causes you to sin..."
 - 3) Remember your Creator (12:1-8)
 - a. To "remember" is more than just mental recall.
 - b. Besides reflecting on and pondering the person and power of God, it also implies an action on our part—obedience!
 - c. Do it while you're young, before you get old (v.v. 3-8)
 - d. Charles Swindoll wrote in his book *Living on the Ragged Edge-* "Gray hair, fewer teeth, yet a big smile."
 - e. So, rejoice, remove and remember!

III. Life is a School; Learn your Lessons from God (12:9-12)

- * In these verses, Solomon explained the characteristics of his words in this book.
 - o For us, the Holy Spirit teaches us the truth of God in the Word of God.
 - o So:
 - 1) Read it
 - 2) Study it
 - 3) Meditate on it
 - a. Psalm 1
 - 4) Memorize it
 - a. While you're young!
 - 5) Obey it
 - a. James- "Be a doer..."

IV. Life is a Stewardship, Fear and Obey God (12:9-12)

- * If you're a Christian, your life is not your own!
 - o We are stewards of all that God has blessed us with!
 - 1) Don't waste your life
 - 2) Don't spend your life
 - 3) Invest your life!

CONCLUSION

- 1) Fear God (v. 13)
 - a. <u>Proverbs 1:7</u>- "The fear of the LORD is the beginning of knowledge"
- 2) Keep His commandments (v. 13)
 - a. If we love God, we will obey God!
 - b. (v. 14) the reason to fear and obey God!
 - i. We will all stand before God in a final judgment
- * Are you ready to face God?
