- B. Jesus did not say why (v. 9)

 - 1. (Acts 12)

 - 1. (John 13)
 - 2. The cross
 - 3. 1000 years (v. 16)
 - a) (Revelation 20)
 - 4. Passover, not the Lord's Supper (v. 17)
 - a) The cup of joy
 - b) Jesus did not drink
- B. Jesus, our Passover Lamb
 - 1. The lamb was selected and inspected on the 10th of Nisan
 - a) (Exodus 12:3)
 - b) Jesus was selected and inspected on the 10th of Nisan
 - c) Palm Sunday
 - 2. The lamb was to be without defect
 - a) (Exodus 12:5)
 - b) (1 Peter 1:19)
 - 3. The lamb was to be sacrificed on the 14th of Nisan at evening or twilight
 - a) (Exodus 12:6)
 - b) Jesus was crucified on the 14th of Nisan at 3pm
 - 4. The bread of the Passover was without leaven
 - a) Jesus was without sin
 - 5. The lamb was to be sacrificed without breaking a bone
 - a) (Exodus 12:46)

- b) Jesus was crucified, and not a bone was broken
 - 1) (John 19:36)
- 6. In Egypt, the Israelites were redeemed by the blood of the lamb
 - a) We are redeemed by the blood of Jesus Christ
 - 1) (1 Peter 1:18-20)

V. The First Lord's Supper (Luke 22:19-20)

A. The cross

- 1. Substitution
- 2. Eucharist (v. 19)
- 3. Only in Luke (v. 19)
- 4. (1 Corinthians 11)
- 5. (Jeremiah 31:31-34)
