Leviticus 17:1-11 - One Way

Main Point: There is only one way to come to God.

Introduction

- What are some different ways that non-believers try to approach God?

Understanding

1. Center for Worship. Read Leviticus 17:1-9.

- a. What laws does the Lord give for worship in these verses? What were the consequences for breaking these laws?
- b. Why did the Lord call for the Israelites to stop individual worship and sacrifice, and bring their offerings to the tabernacle?
- c. How would these verses in Leviticus have been received by the people to whom it was originally written? What would it have meant to them?
- d. Looking at the bigger picture of the Bible, what does chapter 17 tell us about the sinful nature of our hearts?
- e. Why do so many unbelievers want to come to God on their own terms? Why is this a problem?
- f. What does Jesus say about coming to God in John 14:6?

- g. Why do people often think they should “clean up their act” before coming to Jesus?
- h. Read 1 Timothy 2:5. Is a human mediator a requirement for approaching God? If one has to go through a priest to reach God, what does this tell us about coming to Jesus just as we are?
- i. What current day idols keep us from worshiping the Lord?
- j. What bad habits are deeply ingrained in us today that keep us from pleasing God?
- k. What impact do the laws in chapter 17 have on us today?

2. Sacredness of Blood. Read Leviticus 17:10-11.

- a. What was the penalty for disobedience outlined in Leviticus 17:10?
- b. What part of the creature is in the blood? Explain why blood is important in living things.
- c. What does the word “atonement” mean?
- d. In John 1:29-31 what does John the Baptist have to say about Jesus? How does this proclamation connect to Leviticus 17:11?

Application

- What is enslaving you and keeping you from sacrificing your life to God? What are you going to do about it?
