Main Point: Christ promises to come quickly.

Introduction

1. Words of Comfort.

a. Trustworthy And Faithful. Revelation 22:6.

- i. What assurance is given in this verse?

b. I Will Come Quickly. Revelation 22:7.

- i. How can we understand the phrase, "I am coming soon," when it has been a long time since Jesus promised this? Look at 2 Peter 3:8 for more insight.
- ii. What blessing or beatitude is expressed?

c. Worship God only. Revelation 22:8-9.

- i. What mistake did John repeat? Where else had he done it? What should we learn?

d. The Book Is Open, Do Not Seal it. Revelation 22:10-11.

- i. Why is John told not to seal the words of this prophecy?

- ii. What does Revelation 22:11 grant people power to do? Does this mean these practices are acceptable to God?

e. Christ Is Coming With His Rewards. Revelation 22:12-13.

- i. What do 2 Corinthians 5:10 and 1 Corinthians 3:10-15 have to say about rewards for the faithful?

- ii. What is the significance of the terms in Revelation 22:13?

f. Blessed Are Those Who Do His Commandments. Revelation 22:14-15.

- i. What does it mean in this beatitude to “wash their robes”?

- ii. Many groups deny obedience is necessary to receive eternal life. How would you respond?

iii. What is the meaning of “dogs”?

g. “Come”, Jesus’ Final invitation. Revelation 22:16-17.

i. What is the significance of Jesus being the root and descendant of David?

ii. What do Numbers 24:17 and Revelation 2:28 have to say about the morning star?

iii. What is meant by the phrase “the water of life”?

iv. Is it ever too late for people to change their ways and come to Christ? Why or why not?

2. Words of Caution. Read Revelation 22:18-19.

a. What warning is given in these verses?

b. Does this principle apply only to the book of Revelation or to the whole Bible?

3. Closing Benediction. Read Revelation 22:20-21.

- a. What promise does Jesus give to close the book?
