### Introduction

# **Understanding**

- 1. A Lesson on the Sinfulness of Sin. Read Exodus 12:1-14.
  - a. Why did the Lord give such detailed instruction on how the Passover was to be celebrated? Are there any details that stand out to you? Explain.
  - b. Why did the Lord tell the Israelites to sprinkle blood on the doorframes? What would happen to those who did not follow His instructions?
  - c. What does leaven/yeast represent from Exodus 12:8? Why shouldn't it be included in the bread?
  - d. Why would it have been important for Israel's future generations to have these events recorded?
  - e. What do Romans 3:23 and Romans 6:23 teach us about sin?
  - f. Why are we more comfortable talking about the grace and mercy of God than the judgment of God?

#### 2. A Lesson on Substitution. Read Exodus 12:3-5.

- a. What or whom does the Passover lamb represent? What is the connection to the New Testament?
- b. Why is it important that the lamb be without blemish and one year old?
- c. What does the sacrifice of the lamb in Exodus 12 foretell? Refer to 1 Peter 1:18-19.
- d. Explain how Genesis 22:1-8 is a type of salvation story. How does this relate to the sacrifice of Jesus on the cross?

## 3. A Lesson on Salvation. Read Exodus 12: 7, 13, 22-23.

- a. Explain why shed blood is important to salvation.
  - i. Exodus 12: 7, 13, 22-23
  - ii. Leviticus 17:11
  - iii. Hebrews 9:22
  - iv. Romans 5:9
  - v. 1 John 1:7
  - vi. Ephesians 1:7

- 4. A Lesson on Service. Read Exodus 12:11.
  - a. Why was it important for the Israelites to be prepared according to Exodus 12:11?
  - b. What can we learn about ourselves as believers from Ephesians 2:10? How does this relate to our service to God?
