 - d. How can this passage be useful for us? How does it influence our lives?
- 2. The 3 Pillars of the Rapture. Read 1 Thessalonians 4:14-15a.
 - a. What are the three Pillars of the Rapture? Briefly explain each.

- b. What assurance does Paul give about those who sleep in Jesus in 1 Thessalonians 4:14? By what authority does he speak?
- c. Why did Paul stake so much on the historical fact of Jesus' resurrection? Read 1 Corinthians 15:17-19 for additional information.
- d. How important is it for today's Christians to believe Jesus literally rose from the dead?

3. The Participants of the Rapture. Read 1 Thessalonians 4:15b.

- a. What two groups of people participate in the Rapture?
- b. Why did Paul include himself with those who were still alive at the coming of the Lord?
- c. Explain what happens the moment a Christian dies?

4. The Plan of the Rapture. Read 1 Thessalonians 4:16-17.

- a. How is the coming of the Lord described in 1 Thessalonians 4:16-17?
- b. Are lost sinners under consideration in this context, either dead or alive? Explain why or why not.
- c. What does it mean that the dead in Christ will arise? What if they have been cremated or their bodies have decomposed? Where was their soul in the interim?
- d. What additional information does Paul give us in 1 Corinthians 15:50-54?

e. Will we be reunited with our loved ones during the Rapture? Explain.

5. The Profit of the Rapture. Read 1 Thessalonians 4:18.

a. According to 1 Thessalonians 4:18, what benefit can these teachings be to us? Explain how this gives you comfort.
